How we can support you

We want to help you make your event as successful as possible.

Before your event



Plan

Let us know how you're planning to fundraise for us and we can promote it on our social channels. Tell us what you're doing, when and how people can donate along with a photo and we can share with our followers.

We can send you merchandise like t-shirts, caps and beanie hats to wear while doing your fundraising and leaflets and helpline cards to spread the word about what we do.

Making sure your event is safe and legal

If you are hosting an event as part of your fundraising, please keep the following points in mind.

- Licensing and permits – identify if you need this for selling alcohol, playing live music or serving food
- Raffles and gambling – if you're planning any raffle, prize draw, or competition where people pay for a chance to win, please contact us first so we can help you make sure everything meets Scottish and UK regulations.
- Public space – check with your local authority if you need permission for street collections, use of land or traffic management.
- Safety - when planning a public event like a tractor run, make sure you have appropriate health and safety measures in place, including risk assessments, stewards, and safe management of access points.

How we can support you



Start Fundraising

Set up your Justgiving Page and start sharing with friends, family and colleagues

Log in and set up your JustGiving page

Choose RSABI from the list of charities

Tell your story – Add pictures and explain why you are fundraising for RSABI

We also use a handy app which can be used to take donations on your phone. Download the Toucan JustGiving app and join the RSABI campaign.

iOS **Android**

Create a personal account and then link that account to RSABI using this QR code or this code: **y5knEOX6AN**

Once logged in, you select our campaign and use the “take donations” button – to collect a payment



If you'd prefer a quick and convenient way for your donors to donate, we can set up a Text2Donate number using a keyword linked to your fundraising plan, just let us know.

It's always worth checking with your employer if they offer match funding. Lots of companies will support the fundraising efforts of their employees by matching the amount raised, or by making a one-off donation – if its ok with your employer, you could add your link to your work email signature.

If you are hosting an event that requires you to sell tickets you might want to set up an **Eventbrite Page** to manage ticket sales and process payments securely.



Gift Aid allows RSABI to increase the value of your donation at no extra cost to you. If you are a UK taxpayer, we can claim an additional 25p for every £1 you give, directly from HMRC, helping your generosity go even further and ensuring RSABI can reach and support even more people across Scotland's agricultural and rural communities.
